South Lebanon Elementary reading teacher operates a year long after school “YES” Club that meets twice a week for an hour after school. The eighteen students are all 3rd and 4th graders who struggle with reading. Peggy worked with Y staff to help provide swimming lessons as the motivator for children to attend the program.
