IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION - Aquatic Safety is a partnership between great parental supervision and lifeguarding. Thank you for helping us create safe swimming pools!

Children 6, 7, 8 and 9 years old, MUST have a parent or guardian (18 or older) in the POOL AREA at all times. Children must be 10 years old before they may swim at pool without an adult present.

Lap Swimming is for members 13 years and older. Youth ages 6-12 may swim laps if they have passed the swim test (green bracelet) and have an adult swimming laps with them.

Children ages 0-5 years old, are NON-SWIMMERS and will receive a RED bracelet prior to swimming. A parent or guardian, 18 yrs or older must remain within arms reach of children wearing red bracelets. Coast Guard Approved Flotation Devices are permitted.

Children 6-12 years old not passing the deep water swim test are considered NON-SWIMMERS and will receive a YELLOW bracelet. Non-swimmers must remain in shallow water

Children 6-12 years old AND are at least 45 inches tall, must pass the deep water swim test to swim in transitional depth water, use the diving board, water slide, and vortex. Children passing the swim test will receive a GREEN bracelet. See the Lifeguard for swim test and swim test bracelets/stickers.

Babysitters bringing children to a pool must be 18 years of age or older.

Youth ages 0-5 found in the water without adult supervision within arms reach will be reunited with their responsible adult one (1) time per day. If a child is reunited with his/her responsible adult for a second (2nd) time in one day, the family will be asked to leave the pool facilities
